

What is 'Evolution'?


• Change over time = Life is different now than it was a long time ago

or

- Microevolution = Small differences in animal species (example: finch bird beak lengths)
 or
- Universal Common Descent (UCD) = all life had common ancestor, billions of years ago, with slow and gradual change

or

 Neo-Darwinian Evolution (NDE) = Natural selection acting on random mutations (undirected)





"ECs accept evolution as the best scientific explanation we have for how life on Earth has changed over time. In biology, evolution refers to "descent with modification," which includes the idea that all species are descended from a common ancestor over many generations. We therefore accept the scientific evidence that all life on Earth is related, including humans—which does not negate the image of God in us." [BioLogos]

Strengths of EC

- Strong alignment with mainstream (naturalistic) science on life origin and development
- Faithful to essential Christian doctrines of God, salvation, etc.

This position is the one that will be the most agreeable in the secular scientific world

Weaknesses of EC

- Neo-Darwinian evolution theory is flawed and incomplete
- Non-traditional Christian theology regarding Adam & Eve, Image of God, sin, etc.

Many non-Christian biologists are now questioning neo-darwinian evolution, and looking for other explanations

Conclusions

- Evolutionary Creationists (ECs) are Christians, even if they have non-traditional understandings of the Creation Story. All essential Christian doctrines are upheld, though some (like literal Adam & Eve) may not be.
- ECs fully accept the mainstream scientific/naturalistic explanation for the origin and development of life on Earth (Neo-Darwinian evolution) with no need for detectable supernatural intervention. All of God's creative design and action was packed into the supernatural Big Bang start of the Universe.





YEC	God sinks each pool ball perfectly with each shot until the table is clear



Neaderthals lived at the same time as Homo Sapiens, and sometimes mixed with each other. They eventually became extinct. They shared 99.7% of our DNA.

- Were they 'human'?
- Did they have the 'image of God'?
- Were they 'outside' of the Garden of Eden?

Annoying Problems

- Overstating your scientific claims
- Misquoting other's claims
- Ignoring previous discussions with others
- Hiding errors in your past publications
- Not crediting others who corrected your wrong statements

Conclusion: Science (and Theology!) are *not* just hard facts. People are involved, with bias and flaws. Words matter -- make sure that they are being defined properly, stated accurately, and used honestly. Ask for the whole story -- not just the parts that promote a particular viewpoint. Research and verification is hard work!

"So I'm not convinced that evolutionary creationism is true. It seems to me that so-called progressive creationism fits the evidence quite nicely. Progressive creationism suggests that God intervenes periodically to bring about miraculously new forms of life and then allows evolutionary change to take place with respect to those life forms. But as for grand evolutionary change, this would not take place by the mechanisms of natural selection and mutation undirected by God. Rather we would need miraculous interventions of God in the process of biological evolution to bring about broad evolutionary change. So instead of evolutionary creationism, we would have a kind of progressive creationism whereby God creates biological complexity over time." [William Lane Craig]

"The Christian faith does not call for us to put our minds on the shelf, to fly in the face of common sense and history, or to make a leap of faith into the dark. The rational person, fully apprised of the evidence, can confidently believe." [William Lane Craig]

"At BioLogos, our views on human origins are centered on essential biblical teachings about human identity and origins. We join all Christians in affirming that humans are made in the image of God, that humans have an elevated place in the created order, and that humans have a unique relationship with God...we disagree that is it essential to believe God used a miracle to create a first pair; we instead argue that God used the natural mechanisms of evolution to create the first group of humans" [Debora Haarsma]

"But evolution is, as far as we can tell, purposeless and unguided. There seems to be no direction, mutations are random, and we haven't detected a teleological force or agent that pushes it in one direction. And it's important to realize this: the great importance of Darwin's theory of natural selection is that an unguided, purposeless process can nevertheless produce animals and plants that are exquisitely adapted to their environment. That's why it's called natural selection, not supernatural selection or simply selection.


Theistic evolution, then, is supernaturalism, and admitting its possibility denies everything we know about how evolution works. It waters down science with superstition. It should be no crime—in fact, it should be required—for teachers to tell student that natural selection is apparently a purposeless and unguided process (I use the word "apparently" because we're not 100% sure, but really, do we need to tell physics students that the decay of an atom is "apparently" purposeless?)." [Jerry Coyne]

"The only Christian perspective on origins that fully accepts mainstream science is the Evolutionary Creation...This view accepts that humans share ancestry with all other forms of life, and that our species arose as a population, not through a single primal pair...The science (human population genetics) is clear that our species arose as a population" [Dennis Venema]

Top Ten Problems with Darwinian Evolution

- Lack of a viable mechanism for producing high levels of complex and specified information. Related to this are problems with the Darwinian mechanism producing irreducibly complex features, and the problems of non-functional or deleterious intermediate stages.
- The failure of the fossil record to provide support for Darwinian evolution.
- The failure of molecular biology to provide evidence for a grand "tree of life."
- Natural selection is an extremely inefficient method of spreading traits in populations unless a trait has an extremely high selection coefficient;
- The problem that convergent evolution appears rampant at both the genetic and morphological levels, even though under Darwinian theory this is highly unlikely.
- The failure of chemistry to explain the origin of the genetic code.
- The failure of developmental biology to explain why vertebrate embryos diverge from the beginning of development.
- The failure of neo-Darwinian evolution to explain the biogeographical distribution of many species.
- A long history of inaccurate predictions inspired by neo-Darwinism regarding vestigial organs or so-called "junk" DNA.
- Humans show many behavioral and cognitive traits and abilities that offer no apparent survival advantage (e.g. music, art, religion, ability to ponder the nature of the universe).

Apple IPhone Evolved Naturally Over Billions Of Years, Experts Now Believe


WORLD—The consensus is in: scientists from around the globe have confirmed that the Apple iPhone was not designed, but rather evolved naturally over billions of years.

The origins of the complex device have been the subject of scientific debate for many years, but Thursday's announcement puts to bed any doubt that the early ancestors of the iPhone spontaneously generated in a swamp some 4.6 billion years ago.

"The current theory is that a small, single-cell pager device was formed from electronic parts floating in the ocean," Dr. Rashad Shami of Harvard University told reporters. "The pager then figured out how to reproduce, and natural selection took care of the rest."

Scientists also confirmed that anyone who believes that some mythical being named "Steve Jobs" may have had a hand in creating the iPhone is "deluded."

"While the iPhone may have the appearance of design, and, yes, an Apple logo on the back, we assure you, these are happy accidents and not the result of intelligent designers creating the device," Shami said. "The obvious answer to the origin of the highly complex smartphone is that it created itself ex nihilo."

Types of Evolution

- Change over time; history of nature; any sequence of events in nature.
- Changes in the frequencies of alleles in the gene pool of a population.
- Limited common descent: the idea that particular groups of organisms have descended from a common ancestor.
- The mechanisms responsible for the change required to produce limited descent with modification, chiefly natural selection acting on random variations or mutations.
- Universal common descent: the idea that all organisms have descended from a single common ancestor.
- "Blind watchmaker" thesis: the idea that all organisms have descended from common ancestors solely through an unguided, unintelligent, purposeless, material processes such as natural selection acting on random variations or mutations; that the mechanisms of natural selection, random variation and mutation, and perhaps other similarly naturalistic mechanisms, are completely sufficient to account for the appearance of design in living organisms.

Is Evolutionary Creation true?

- Were Adam and Eve real people?
- Were they the first and only ancestors (sole progenitors) of all people?
- Did God create them as a special act of creation (de novo = from dust & rib)?
- When did they live?
- How were they made in the image of God (imagio dei)? Characteristics or role?
- How was God involved in creating and changing life on Earth, and is there evidence?

Questions to ask:

 Is our faith dependent on how God created all things? In an actual supernaturally-created Adam and Eve? Or does it just rely on belief in Jesus as God, savior, and Lord of our lives?
