- Environmentalism
 - → Earth belongs to humanity

 - → People are the biggest problem
- Creation Care
 - → Earth belongs to our Creator
 - → We are stewards
 - → Our concern is for both nature and people

Biblical basis for creation care...

...nature: it is not our own. It belongs to God, and we are to exercise our dominion over these things not as though entitled to exploit them, but as things borrowed or held in trust. We are to use them realizing they are not ours intrinsically. Man's dominion is under God's dominion.

Potential Impacts of Global Climate Change on Human Health


Global climate change effects:

- Precipitation




